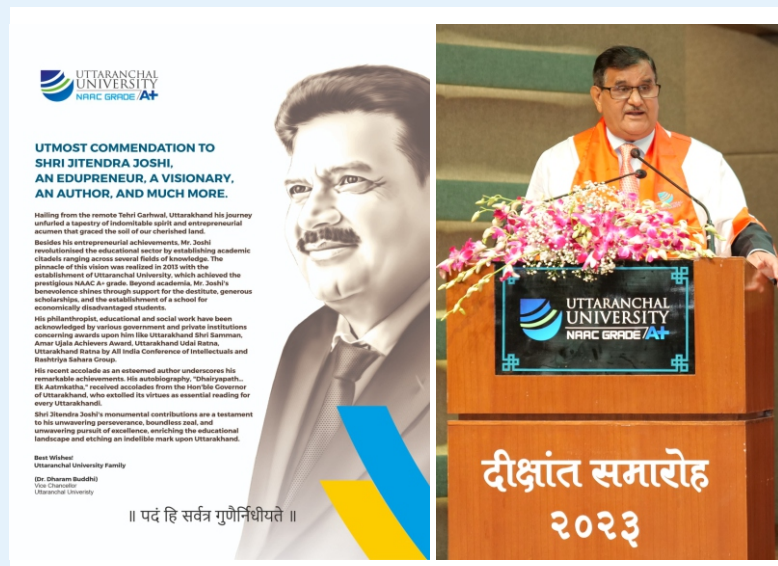
Acknowledging the Author

HODs, Faculty members, students, and Library professionals. 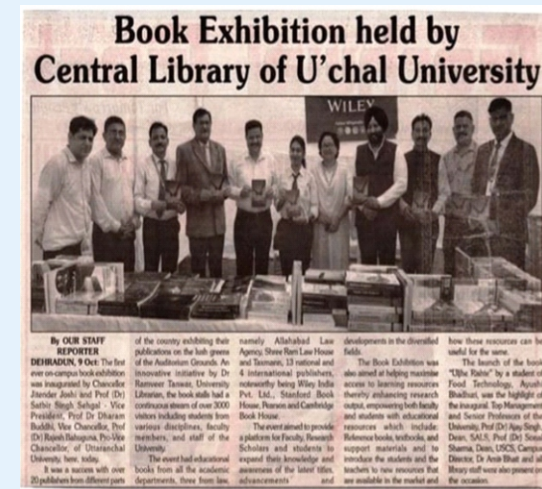

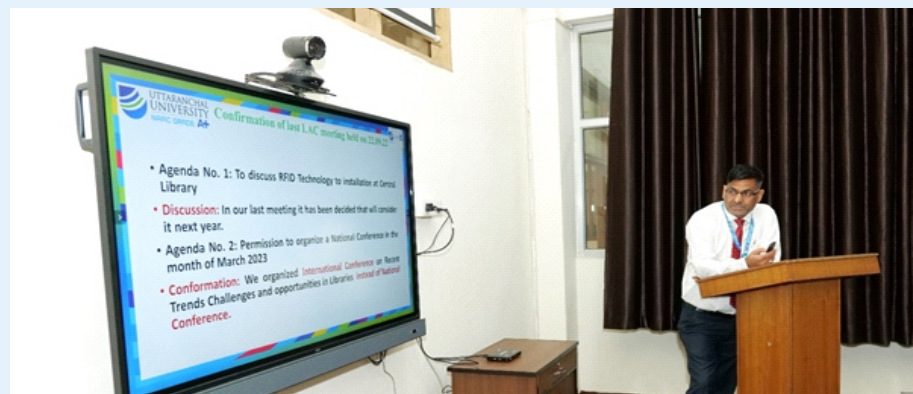
Organized a Demo on AI-powered Kibo Kits:

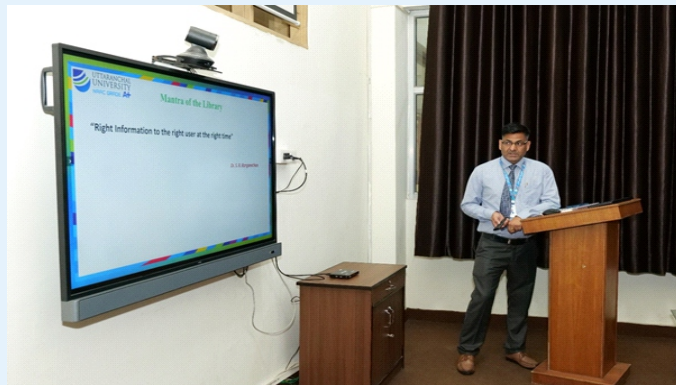
Orientation Programme
