The first issue of the Central Library e-newsletter provided an overview of available resources and services and highlighted key initiatives. Subsequent issues of the Bibliotheca Bulletin have continually strengthened connections with the UU user community.

The highlight of this 5th special issue features research support services initiated by the Central Library. This newsletter is circulated via group mail to all members of Uttaranchal

University and is published on the library's website. The library e-newsletter is published bi-annually.

### **CENTRAL LIBRARY AT UTTARANCHAL UNIVERSITY**

The Central Library is an iconic structure located in the heart of Uttaranchal University's campus. Spanning 2,330 square meters, the library building is surrounded by a beautiful garden and boasts a precisely arranged internal wooden architecture.

This two-storied, aesthetically designed building features plenty of natural light, radiant cooling, and an air-handling unit, with a seating capacity of over 600. The library is equipped with modern technology, including KIOSK systems and the LIBCYB ERP system, ensuring minimal human interference.

The library has dedicated group discussion rooms, digital library, text section, bound volumes section, reading room periodical and reference section and fifty-seat media centre having the provisions of AC, LED, Projector where students can work in a group and provides an avenue for training and user orientation of the large group. The friendly and approachable library staff are happy to answer queries, arrange inter-library loans and receive suggestions for new acquisitions. The Library supports learning and research by prioritizing digital collections and providing excellent study environments and facilities.

#### **Library Automation**

Library operations are fully automated using the LIBCYB ERP system, encompassing modules for member registration, item circulation, cataloging, serial management, report generation, and online support.

#### **Library Collection**

The Central Library houses over 200,000 documents, including books, theses, print journals, dissertations, magazines, newspapers, CDs, and conference proceedings. These resources cover diverse fields such as law, engineering, computing sciences, agriculture, life sciences, humanities, social sciences, nursing, health sciences, Ayurveda, pharmacy, management, and hotel management.

All in-house operations are fully computerized using an Integrated Library Management System, which also provides web-based access to the catalog of the central library and departmental libraries.

## **LIBRARY SERVICES AND FACILITIES**

The UU Libraries offer a wide range of services catering to their users' diverse needs. From providing access to a vast collection of books and resources to delivering innovative programs and technologies, libraries have become dynamic hubs of knowledge and community engagement. This brief overview will explore some of the key library services that contribute to the enrichment of individuals, support education and research, foster literacy and lifelong learning, and promote community development. Whether it's traditional services like lending materials and reference assistance or modern initiatives like digital resources and maker spaces, libraries play a vital role in connecting people with information and creating inclusive spaces for exploration, discovery, and personal growth.

The UU Libraries offers a wide array of facilities and services to meet the academic and research needs of its users:

### **SERVICES**

These are Services provided by the library to the users. This can include instruction on how to access and use library materials.

• **Reference services:** Reference Service is an important service offered by the library. It also maintains a collection of reference books consisting of encyclopaedias, dictionaries, Cds.

• Open Access: It provides open access to all library users. They can browse, read the any references in the library. It helps users to make full use of the resources available in the central library.

• Library OPAC: The resources of the library have been computerized with integrated library management software that, library staff members assisting to search books, Users can search the resources by author, title, subject, key words etc.

• **Circulation Services:** This service is offered to all library users through Libcyb ERP LMS software. The resources borrowed from the library shall be returned on or before the due date during library working hours. Its terms and conditions are mentioned in Library Rules and Regulations.

• Periodical Service: The magazines and journals are made available to the users. all the users have to read in library only

• Current Awareness Services: Informing users about new library acquisitions through display boards, shelves, or lists. v Selective Dissemination of Information (SDI). Selective Dissemination of Information (SDI) services offered by libraries are designed to address the information needs of individual users in a personalized and targeted manner.

• Online Library Services: Online library services have revolutionized the way we access and interact with information. These services provide users with convenient and seamless access to vast resources, regardless of their physical location.

• Information Services: Library information services are crucial in connecting users with the information available within libraries.

• **News-Paper clipping service:** All newspapers are containing very important news of UU on various events and programme which are very useful to the readers.

• Orientation and Information Sessions: Library conducts orientation programmes for new users at beginning of the session. It is to enable them to use library resources effectively.

• Wi-Fi Facility: The entire Library is Wi-Fi enabled; users can use their configuration laptops to access in the central library.

• **Previous Year Question Papers:** Providing previous year question papers made available in ERP is for users as reference services.

• Audio-visual Services: Providing educational and recreational audio-visual materials

• Multimedia: Providing multimedia services

• Inter-library Loan Services: Providing inter-library loan services

### **FACILITIES**

• **Reading Room Facility:** The Central Library has two fully air-conditioned reading halls with a total capacity of 114 students and faculty. A separate reading room with a seating capacity of 296 available for students and faculty members.

• **Property Counter:** The Central Library offers the facility of property counter to its users. Users are required to keep their Bags (excluding valuable items such as money, passport, credit/debit cards/mobile phones etc.) at the property counter before entering into the library.

• **KIOSK Facility:** The Central Library allows users to search for an item of interest available in the Library holdings at KIOSK. KIOSK are available in the library to facilitate this service. The users may search by: Title, Author, Subject and Key Words, Publisher and Call Number.

• **Circulation(Issue/Return):** The Circulation system in the library provides a number of services such as: Registration of new members and renew the membership of existing members, check-out (issue) and check-in (return) of books, reservation of books, and generation of reminder letter for overdue documents. Library users can see & verify their transaction through ERP.

• **Reference Service:** The Central Library provides access to all reference collections including encyclopaedias, year books, dictionaries, directories, competition books etc. The library staff assists the users to solve their queries and also provide them the needed documents.

• New Arrival Display Service: Newly added books to the library are displayed on the New Arrival Display before they are released for loan.

• **Plagiarism Check Facility:** Plagiarism Detection software i.e. Turnitin is being subscribed by the Central Library. The Faculty members and research scholars of the University can use this facility to check plagiarism in research articles, dissertation, book chapters, reports etc. To avail the services, please contact the Sr. Grade Librarian and University librarian.

• **Remote Access:** Knimbus is proving by the Central Library for accessing subscribed on line resources for the library users.

• User Orientation and Awareness Service: All the newly enrolled students are made aware about the various facilities provided by the Central Library every year

during Induction/Orientation Programme organized on the very first day of the start of the new academic session.

• **Periodical Section:** This section facilitates new magazines, newspapers and print journals to students and faculty members of the University.

### **LIBRARY POLICIES**

#### **Library Procurement Policy**

The Central Library follows a well-defined book procurement procedure to cater to the academic needs of students and faculty. Book recommendations are accepted through

book exhibitions, individual requests, and faculty suggestions. After verifying for duplicates, the recommended list is submitted to the competent authority for administrative and financial approval before ordering.

### **LIBRARY CIRCULATION POLICY**

Membership is extended to all students, research scholars, and faculty members of Uttaranchal University.

Only enrolled students, faculty, researchers, and staff are permitted to use the library resources.

A valid University Identity Card is required for all library transactions.

The library currently serves around 13,000 registered members.

#### Inter-Library and Intra-Campus Library Loan

The Central Library has a membership of DLNET through which it provides Inter-Library Loans services connecting over 8,981 member libraries pan India. Requests can be made via email lrc@uumaiil.in or by requesting through departmental libraries.

### **LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP:**

All students, research scholars and faculty members of the Uttaranchal University are entitled to the membership of the Library. Only enrolled Students, Researchers, Faculty and Staff as registered members are permissible to use Library and its resources. The Library currently has about 13,000 members.
