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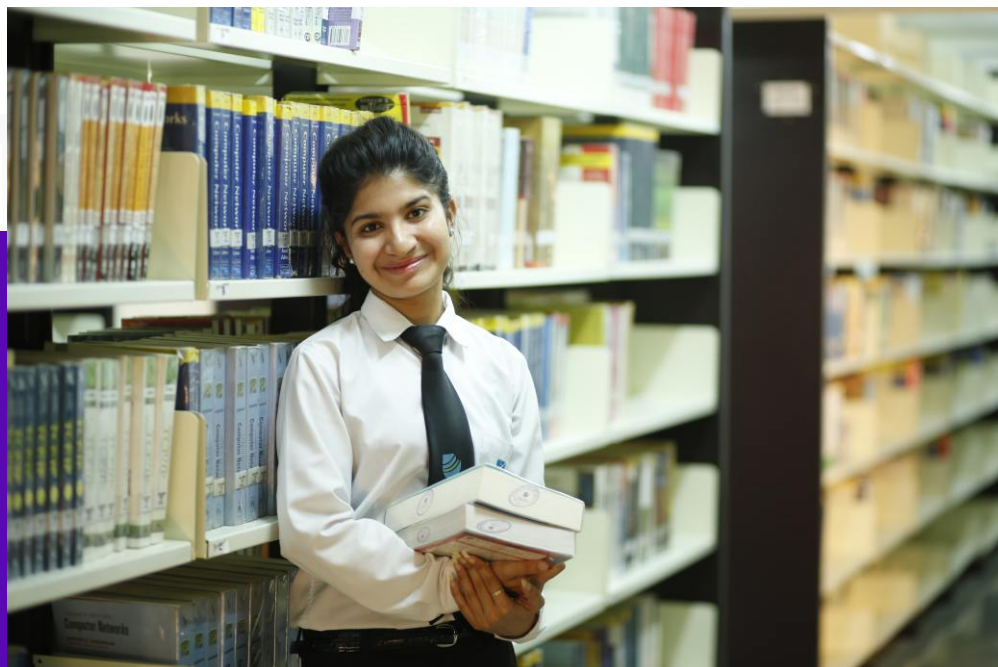

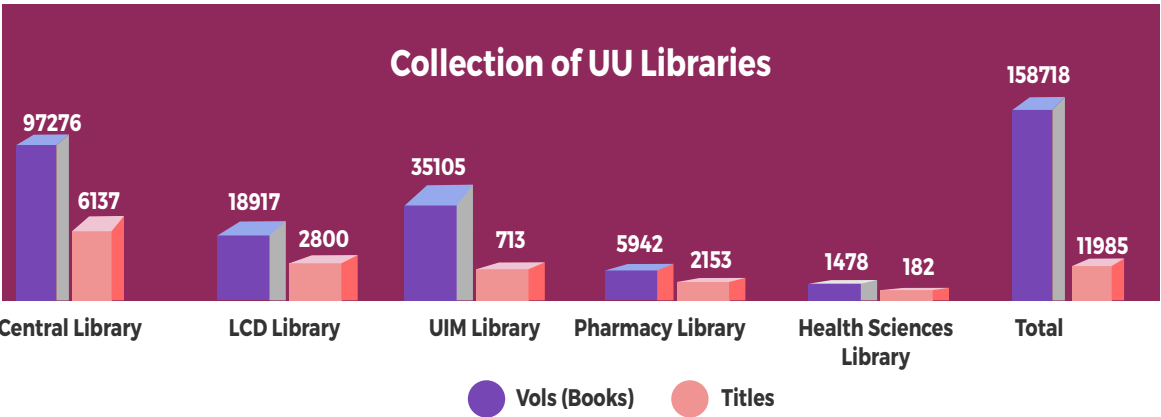
GLIMPSE OF KNOWLEDGE RESOURCE CENTRE

The Knowledge Resource Centre (KRC) at Uttaranchal University offers a balanced combination of print and digital collections. Keeping in pace with the above spirit and Uttaranchal University's goal to 'promote quality education,' the spacious Knowledge Resource Centre (KRC) offers a platform for research, innovation, and development. The resources are provided with the most recent editions of databases, books, journals, periodicals, e-journals, and publications from well-known national and international publishers. Online and digital learning resources, which can be accessed 24/7, are the library's main area of focus. The library is fully automated with the help of the ERP-LIBCYB- integrated library management system.

The KRC has a rich collection of more than 160718 volumes with 11985 unique titles related to Engineering, Management, CSE, Applied and Life Sciences, Law, Pharmacy, Nursing, Hotel & Hospitality Management, Agriculture, Journalism & Mass Media, and Health Science. 156514 e-books and 44148 online journals are spread across all the

libraries located in different academic blocks of the university campus. The LCD Library provides an innovative and comprehensive information environment for study and scholarship to prepare students for responsible and productive lives in the legal Profession and to support national and international leadership in improving the law and legal institutions through teaching, research, and public services. Library collection development

policy emphasises the acquisition of primary and secondary resources on law and allied subjects. It primarily focuses on treatises and commentaries, reporting and academic journals, reports and proceedings, legislative and constitutional material, dissertations and theses, moot memorials, encyclopaedias, and digests, as well as an extensive range of national and international electronic resources to access digital contents 24 hours a day, seven days a week, within and outside the campus via remote access services.

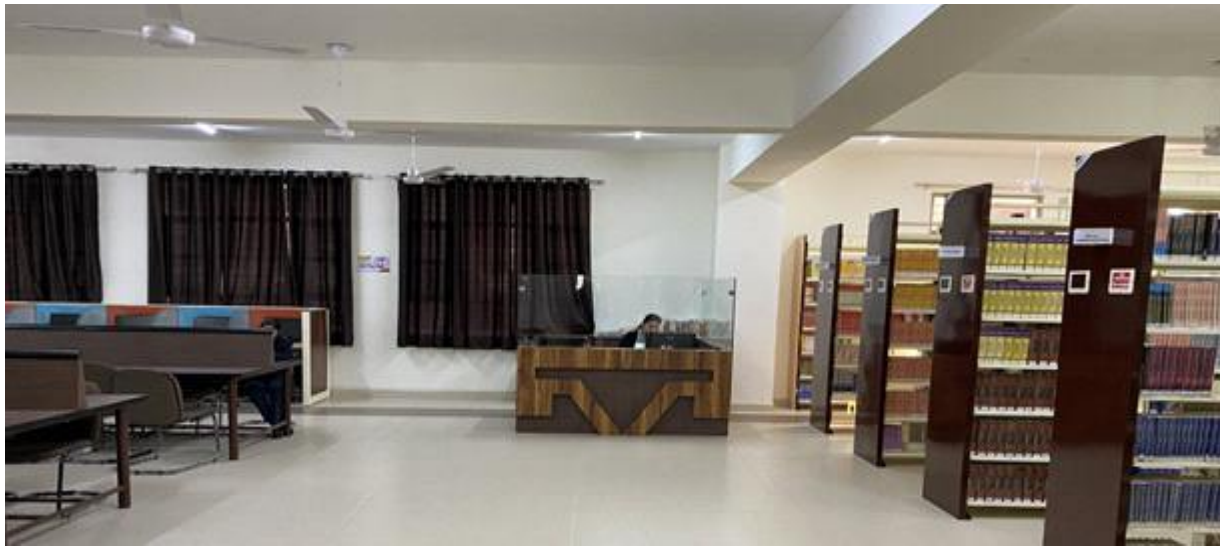
About the Print Collection

The Law College Dehradun Library has an excellent collection and broad coverage in national, foreign, and comparative law. The library's comprehensive print collection includes a series of commentaries on law, a reference collection, encyclopaedias, legal dictionaries, yearly digests, etc. The collection focuses on legal subjects to support research and scholarship and has strong emphasis on AIR Civil cases, AIR Law Lines, AIR Check, AIR, Company Law

Journal, Labour, Industrial cases, Lucknow Law Times, Right to information Reporter, Supreme Court Cases, Supreme Law Today, Uttarakhand Case, Dehradun Law Review, Economic and Political Weekly, Indian Bar Review, Indian Journal of Society and Politics, Journal of Indian Law Institute, Legal News and Views, Social Action, Uttarakhand Business Review, University News, and many more.

Pharmacy Library

The Pharmacy Library was established in July 2016 with (approx. Vols. 5942 + Titles - 2153) a sizable collection of books. The library has multidisciplinary resources with a focus on educational studies and updated information.

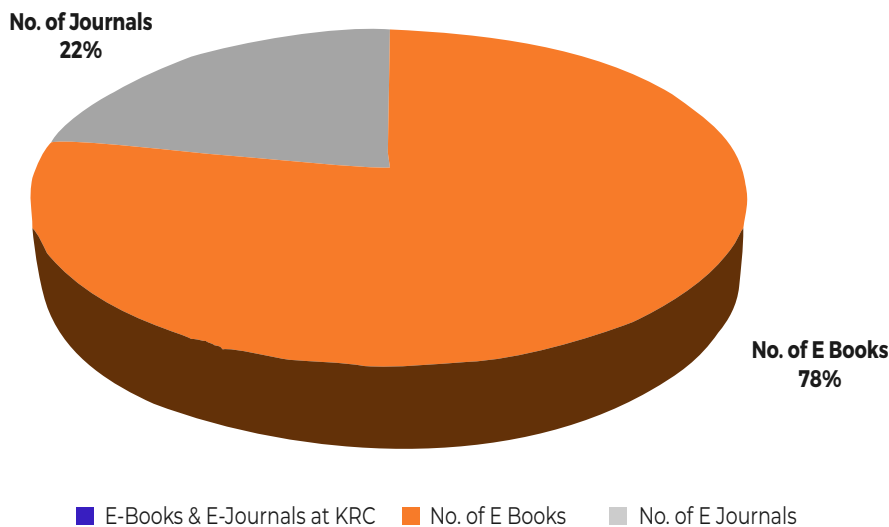


Health Science Library

Library procurement policy of books and periodicals

Library has a fairly comprehensive book procurement procedure to facilitate the needs of the faculty members and students. Library accepts recommendation through various methods like book exhibition, individual recommendation and request by the faculty. Library checks duplication of recommended books and places the list of recommended books before the competent authority to obtain its administrative as well as financial approval before ordering the books.

Inter-library loan is available to Central Library users via DELNET. Under this facility, all users can borrow books through DELNET, which operates an inter-library loan service with more than 7000 member libraries across the world. Library circulation policy

This is one of the key features of library services. Students must present an identity card issued by the university in order to use the lending (issue or return) service. The KRC lending service is fully computerized with Bar-Code Technology through ERP Library Management Software. The books

can be checked out and returned under the specific library rules. The library has classified borrowing limits and time period on the basis of courses. The following is the existing pattern of circulation systems:

The KRC offers designated study areas and a discussion room for student engagement. The Group Discussion Room's amenities are solely for use by UU students and academic staff during group discussions.

Digital Library:

A digital library is a collection of documents in organized electronic form, available on the Internet or on CD-ROM (compact disk read-only memory) disks. We have 42 computer systems in the digital library to access magazine articles, books, papers, images, sound files, and videos.

Media Centre:

The Media Centre is also available for the preparation of assignments and presentations for library users at KRC with the prior permission of the University Librarian. In this section, users can access NPTL Videos and other resources.

Newspaper Section:

The Library has subscribed 14 newspapers at KRC in Hindi & English Covering National & State level.

Periodical Section:

The users may access updated print journals, magazines, bound volumes, rare books and Ph. D theses also inside the periodical section premises.

Reference Service:

The users may approach the circulation counter for any information or any type of assistance regarding the use of KRC resources and services. The KRC does have separate collections of reference and reserve materials for short queries such as encyclopaedias, dictionaries, handbooks, maps, text books, general books, competitive exam books, personality development books, and authors from Uttaranchal University (UU), etc.

Stack Section:

In an open-stack library, patrons are free to enter the stacks to browse the collection and retrieve items that interest them. The most important section of the library is the stacks. Its function is to display and maintain books that are issued on loan. The whole section is arranged in different racks or shelves. Members have the facility to have open access to most of the collections available in this section.

Books are arranged on the shelves according to the Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme. Each book is assigned a class number and a book number. Class Number is assigned to a book according to its subject, and Book Number identifies a book among others having the same Class Number. In this arrangement, books on the same subject are kept together. Members are advised to check the availability of the books through the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) Service. After obtaining relevant information through OPAC, the users can proceed to the respective stack area to take the books of their choice.

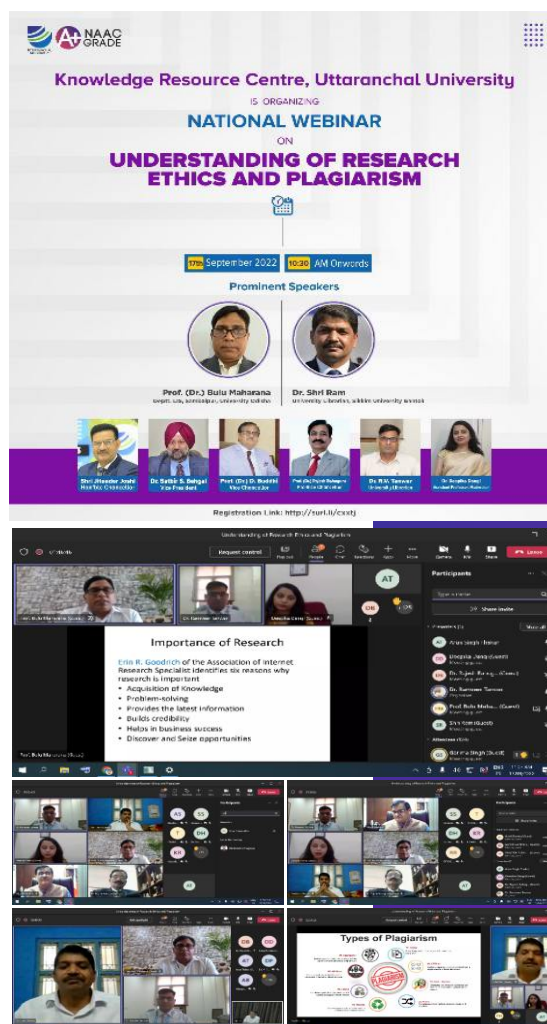
National Webinar

The Knowledge Resource Centre, Uttaranchal University, Dehradun, organised an interactive session on the topic **"Understanding Research Ethics and Plagiarism"** on September 17, 2022. The webinar received 554+ registrations from all over India.

Prof. (Dr) Bulu Maharana, Head LIS Department, Sambalpur University, Odisha, and Dr Shri Ram, University Librarian, Sikkim University, Gangtok, presented an informative session on "Understanding Research Ethics and Plagiarism" during the webinar. The event was moderated by Dr Deepika Dangi, Asst Professor from the School of Applied Life Sciences, Uttaranchal University, Dehradun, with opening remarks on the webinar. She introduced all the panelists: the Vice Chancellor, Prof. (Dr) Dharam Buddhi, Pro Vice- Chancellor, Prof. (Dr) Rajesh Bahuguna, Webinar Convener, Dr Ramveer Tanwar, and Resource Persons, Prof. (Dr) Bulu Maharana, Head of Library and Information Science Sambalpur University, Odisha, and Dr Shri Ram University Librarian, Gangtok, Sikkim.

Dr Ramveer Tanwar, the University Librarian at Uttaranchal University, Dehradun, welcomed all 220 participants, distinguished speakers, and upper management. The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. (Dr) Dharam Buddhi and Pro VC, Prof. (Dr) Rajesh Bahuguna, shared wise words with the participants and motivated them to do quality research in their respective areas. Both resource persons expressed their detailed views on the following topics: Principles of research ethics and issues of research misconduct, ethical norms,

principles in research, research integrity, research misconduct; Avoiding plagiarism in academic writing: A methodological approach, research type, and forms; Plagiarism avoidance techniques, paraphrasing, reference management software, and tools to avoid plagiarism along with the legal aspects of plagiarism. At the end, a vote of thanks was proposed by Mr Arun S. Thakur, Sr. Grade Librarian, to the participants in the event.



National Webinar

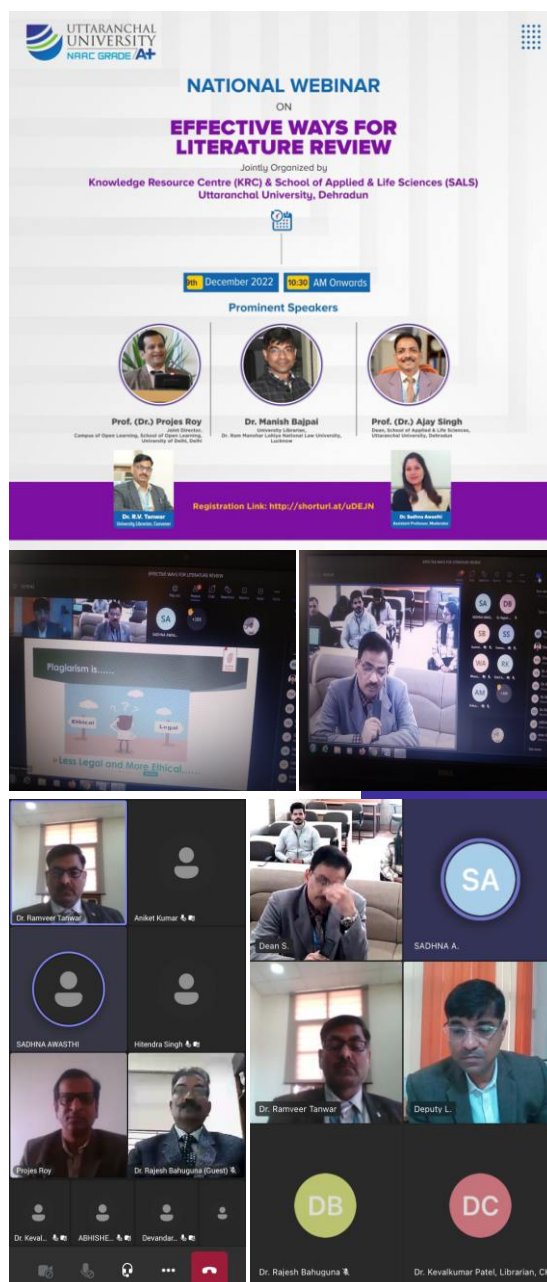
