
Created Bound Volumes of Journal Section:




REMOTE ACCESS USAGE


Total Remote Access Login from 01.06.2022 to 31.05.2023 Total Login 27031 i.e. About 74 Login/Day




LIBRARY FEEDBACK SURVEY BY THE STUDENTS WITH IQAC









Are you satisfied with the Circulation Section ?






Are you satisfied with the Acquistion Section ?






Are you satisfied with the Bound Periodical Section ?








The SDP Programme received an overwhelming response around 35 participants from different departments, including KRC, Administration, HR Department, IT Department, and Lab Technicians, actively took part in this event. The session proved to be highly fruitful and informative for all the participants. The SDP managed to captivate the interest of enthusiastic and motivated staff members who were eager to learn and expand their knowledge. The KRC professionals and administrative staff gained valuable insights throughout the programme.

The programme was inaugurated in the morning at Knowledge Resource Centre in Media Centre on 10th June 2023 by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Dharam Buddhi, Prof. (Dr.) Sonal Sharma, Dean USCS, Er. Rajesh Derari, Director IQAC, Dr. Ramveer Tanwar, University Librarian, Manisha Khanduja, Mr. Arun Singh Thakur, Sr. Grade Librarian and Dr. Rakhi Sharma, Asst. Librarian.

In the inauguration session Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Dharam Buddhi addressed the gathering and emphasized the importance of Staff Development Programme (SDP). Prof. (Dr.) Dharam Buddhi advised the conveners to organize more such events in the university.





Resource Persons The expert speakers of the SDP were:

Mr. Keshav Gupta Assistant Professor, USCS, Uttaranchal University, delivered an expert talk on create, manipulate and present documents using MS Word. He shed some light on the significance of MS Word. Particularly the in basics including the introduction to layout, auto-correct and spell-check, text formatting, page and section break, column-break, header, footer, font style, insert symbol and special characters, smart-art and shapes and icons, drop cap, insert footnote, mail-merge, track changes, protect document, page set up and print.

The expert speaker, **Mr. Parminder Singh**, Assistant Professor, USCS, Uttaranchal University, focused on addressing crucial aspects of analyzing, managing and presenting data using MS-Excel.

He further introduced the participants to the basic formulae, functions including formatting cells, sorting and filtering data along with basic charts, data validation, advanced formulae and functions, conditional formatting, formatting, conditional statements and pivot tables.

Mr. Praveen Shah, Assistant Professor, USCS, Uttaranchal University introduced the participants to MS – PowerPoint. He further discussed the details of creating and managing presentations by using the various functions of power point such as themes, background formatting, transitions, animations, slide show, etc. He also explained that the management of slides can be done by employing master slide.

Prof. (Dr.) Sonal Sharma introduced the programme in a systematic manner. She enlightened all the participants about the significance of tools, techniques, and best practices of IT, Cloud Computing, Google Drives, Chat GPT, Artificial Intelligence and Data Analysis.


