
A few of the sustainable Agriculture farming practices in Uttaranchal University


University Students' connecting with the Local farmers in the nearby vicinity





A highlight of this program is the billeting of students on Agri-based enterprises to gain expertise and confidence in organizing and nurturing Agri-based self-employment ventures in rural contexts. The program culminates with a **fortnight-long stay** in a selected village with the objective of diagnosing field problems and developing socio-economic, viable projects to address the issues encountered in the field in a participatory mode.








Procurement Practices
